**EMERGENCY DECLARATION
WAIVER OF IFTA REQUIREMENTS FOR PENNSYLVANIA**

Due to recent severe weather which has resulted in power outages and related supply shortages throughout Pennsylvania and our neighboring states, and relative to Governor Tom Corbett's February 5, 2014 Proclamation of Emergency, a temporary waiver of International Fuel Tax Agreement (IFTA) requirements is hereby issued by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

The purpose of this waiver ensures the expeditious restoration of utilities to Pennsylvania residents in areas which have been impacted by recent weather emergencies, and for other qualified motor vehicles (75 Pa. C.S. Section 2101.1) that are providing emergency related supplies. Therefore, this waiver applies to qualified motor vehicles traveling into or through Pennsylvania which are providing the restoration of power and emergency supplies to this Commonwealth or other affected states. This waiver takes effect at 12 p.m. on Monday, March 3, 2014, and will expire at 11:59 p.m. on Monday, March 31, 2014.

This waiver announcement is being released immediately to allow out-of-state vehicles that are providing restoration of utilities and emergency supplies a means of rapid entry and deployment. In addition, this waiver will prevent the ticketing and/or detention of utility and supply restoration crews entering into the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
